



Third Bonn Mannheim PhD Workshop

Call for Papers

One-day workshop at the University of Mannheim

The aim of this workshop is to provide a venue for PhD students to present and discuss their ongoing work and to facilitate the scientific exchange between the members of the Bonn and Mannheim graduate schools. The workshop is organized by doctoral students from Bonn and Mannheim.

Outline of the workshop

The workshop is not restricted to a specific field, but invites participants from all fields of economics. Presentations will start at around 10am, and finish at around 6pm. There will be parallel sessions grouped by fields. The official program will be followed by a social gathering. We will provide lunch, coffee and snacks. More information will follow once we know the number of people participating.

Participation

There are 3 different ways to participate. You can either present your own work, discuss the presentation of another student or just come and listen to the presentations and meet fellow PhD students.

If you want to present: Time for the presentation will be 25 minutes, followed by a discussion of the presentation by another student of 5 minutes. If you want to present, send us an extended abstract (maximum one page) of the paper you want to present. Before the workshop (about two weeks), you should have a draft of the paper ready for your discussant. In case there are more people interested in presenting than slots are available, people closer to the job market will get priority.

If you want to discuss a paper: Send us an e-mail stating your fields of interest. We will try to allocate you a paper that matches your stated interests closely. Our aim is that you discuss a paper from someone from the other university.

If you just want to participate: Just let us know that you want to join, stating your year and field of interest. However, if there are not enough discussants, we might ask you to discuss a paper.
